


## How to use the Carver Owners Club Forum



I have found the rear lights are the exact dimensions as the Moffit Mounty Rear Forklift, They are Dual Voltage – 12/24VDC, I upgraded these the rear light to LEDS from the original, They look great ( Stylish ) and operate far more effectively ( Brighter and Quicker with less voltage drain on the headlights ), I recommend this as an optional extra. You need the light unit and the choke to arrest the current delivery... If you don't use the choke the indicators flash faster due to the lessor draw of power.


